**a) Exploration of the Academic World I**

- This course is designed to develop critical, creative, and interdisciplinary thinking skills, which are essential for the “pioneering intellectuals” who will address the world's challenges and shape the future of society. Students admitted in 2023 or earlier are required to take “Exploration of the Academic World I” (required liberal arts course) and “Exploration of the Academic World II” (required liberal arts course). Students admitted in 2024 or later are required to take “Exploration of the Academic World I” (required liberal arts course) and “Exploration of the Academic World II” (elective liberal arts course).

**b) College Writing**

- New students should check with their college to see which semester they need to take the course and sign up for it.

- Separate classes are offered for student athletes, department of Cyber Defense majors, international students, and repeaters (including students who are not freshmen and have never taken this course before).
- Students who are not freshmen and are repeating or taking this course for the first time must sign up for the “Repeaters Only” class.

- Freshmen required to take these courses will be automatically placed in a separate class for their department (For first-semester incoming freshmen, they will be automatically enrolled in the first semester, but must manually register for the course in the second semester).
- Repeaters, students who are not freshmen and have never taken these courses before, and transfer students must manually register for separate classes for their major.
- “There are “advisor-led classes,” “online classes” and “departmental programs.”
- For more information on how to sign up for the courses and how to take them, please check the academic calendar announcement on the KU portal.
- These courses will be graded at the discretion of the “Freshman Seminar instructor.”
- They are mentoring-oriented courses and do not need to be taken in the order of “Freshman Seminar I” and “Freshman Seminar II.”
- For students admitted in 2017 or earlier, please check for courses similar to “GEKS001 and GEKS002 Freshman Seminar” at Course Registration > Course Search > Similar Undergraduate Courses.
- For students admitted between 2018 and 2023, please check for courses similar to “GEKS005 Freshman Seminar I” and “GEKS006 Freshman Seminar II” at Course Registration > Course Search > Similar Undergraduate Courses.

**d) Academic English I**

- Following the abolition of the “Online English Proficiency Test for Freshmen,” students admitted from Fall 2024 onward must select their class level independently (Foundation or Intermediate) and register accordingly.

- During the first week of the semester, if the instructor determines that a student’s proficiency level does not match the level of the enrolled section (Foundation or Intermediate), the instructor may request the student to change sections. In such cases, the student must change sections personally during the course add/drop period.
- Students who submit an official English proficiency test score that meets the advanced-level exemption criteria to the University College Administration Team via email ([geedcredu@korea.ac.kr](mailto:geedcredu@korea.ac.kr)) before the start of the semester in which they are admitted will be exempt from taking Academic English I. (Scores submitted after the start of the semester will not be accepted, and exemptions cannot be granted thereafter.)
- Any credits waived as a result of this exemption must be fulfilled through general education or major courses in accordance with the student’s graduation requirements.

※ This exemption policy is operated separately from the submission of certified English proficiency test scores required by the student’s home department for graduation purposes.

- Students admitted in 2026 are recommended to take IFLS800 Academic English I in either their first or second semester of their freshman year, and are required to complete the course prior to graduation.
- Students admitted in or before 2023 must complete IFLS800 Academic English I and IFLS801 Academic English II sequentially. (Academic English II may only be taken after successfully completing Academic English I.)

- For students admitted from the 2012 cohort onward, first-time enrollment in Academic English I and II is permitted only during regular semesters.  
(Enrollment in summer or winter sessions is allowed only for **retake purposes**; first-time enrollment during seasonal sessions is not permitted.)
- Except for freshmen admitted in Fall 2026, students who need to retake or who have not yet completed the required courses must register for the designated “Retake/Incomplete” class sections.
- Korean-national transfer students must directly register for the “Intermediate-level Retake/Incomplete” section.
- Students who did not take the “Online English Proficiency Test for Freshmen” at the time of admission may freely choose between the Foundation-level or Intermediate-level Retake/Incomplete sections.  
Please refer to the recommended criteria for the Intermediate level when selecting a section.
- However, students who previously took the “Online English Proficiency Test for Freshmen” must register for the class section corresponding to their assigned level.
- Please note that separate class sections are designated for student-athletes and medical students.

**e) Coding Courses (for students admitted in 2024 or later)**

You can build your digital literacy skills by taking “**SW Programming Basics**” in the 1<sup>st</sup> semester and “**Data Science and Artificial Intelligence**” in the 2<sup>nd</sup> semester.

※ Students admitted in 2023 or earlier and intending to retake the courses or have not yet taken them must complete “Computational Thinking,” which is offered in the second semester of each year.

**f) Bio Courses (for students admitted in 2024 or later)**

“**The World of Bioscience**” (MOOC) explores the fundamentals of biotechnology and various examples of convergent technologies that utilize life phenomena to foster interdisciplinary thinking that will enable students to cope with the changing environment and lead the future.

**II. Elective Liberal Arts Courses**

The Elective Liberal Arts Courses are designed to expose students to a variety of disciplines and applied fields, and include Distributed Category Liberal Arts (formerly, Core General Education: World Cultures, History, Literature and Art, Ethics and Philosophy, Sociological Studies, Science and Technology, Digital Innovation and Humanity) and other Elective Liberal Arts courses (including arts and physical education). Physical Education courses can be taken for a maximum of three credits (three one-credit courses) before graduation.

※ Core general education courses are Required Liberal Arts Courses for students admitted in 2023 or earlier, and **Elective Liberal Arts Courses** for students admitted in 2024 or later.
