1. 교육과정은 입학 연도의 교육과정이 적용됩니다. 단, 간호학과의 교육과정 개편(신교육과정)으로 인하여 입학 연도의 교육과정 이수가 불가능한 경우, 신교육과정이 적용될 수 있습니다.

2. 교육과정 개편에 따라 학번별로 적용되는 교육과정이 상이하므로 이수해야 할 교과목에 착오 없도록 유의하시기를 바랍니다. (이수구분 변경, 학점, 교과목 신설(폐지) 등)

3. 교육과정 개편으로 인한 교과목명 및 학수번호 변경에 유의하여 수강신청 하시기를 바랍니다.

- 확인방법 : 포탈 → 강의 → 개설과목조회 → 학부 유사과목/학부 삭제(유사폐지)과목

4. 재수강하고자 하는 과목 및 재수강했던 과목이 정리되지 않은 학생은 이수학점에 착오가 없도록 간호대학 행정실로 문의 바랍니다.

5. 재학기간 내에 외국어 강의 3과목 이상을 필수로 수강하여야 합니다. (고려대학교 공통 졸업요구조건)

6. 간호대학 전공과목들은 꼭 과목명의 순서를 지켜서 순서대로 수강 신청을 진행해야 합니다. (예: 기초간호과학1을 수강 후 기초간호과학2를 수강할 것)

7. 간호대학의 수업은 고려대학교에서 일반적으로 진행되는 75분 수업 모듈과는 다른 방식으로 수업을 진행합니다. 수강 신청시 비고란에 있는 실제 수업시간을 꼭 확인 후 수강신청을 진행하시기 바랍니다.

※ Please carefully review the following important notes to ensure there are no errors in course registration and completion.

1. The curriculum for the year of admission will be applied. However, due to curriculum revisions in the Nursing Department (new curriculum), if it is not possible to complete the curriculum for the year of admission, the new curriculum may be applied.

2. Please note that the curriculum varies depending on the student ID number due to the curriculum revision, so please be careful not to make any mistakes in the courses you need to complete. (Changes in course classification, credits, new courses (or discontinued courses), etc.)

3. Please pay attention to changes in course names and course numbers due to the curriculum revision when registering for courses.

- How to check: Portal → Courses → Course Information → Undergraduate Course Retroactive Substitution/Undergraduate Course Cancellation List

4. Students who have not yet organized their courses for retaking or previously retaken courses should contact the College of Nursing Administration Office to avoid errors in their credit hours.

5. Students must complete at least three foreign language courses during their enrollment period. (General requirements for graduation at Korea University)

6. Nursing major courses must be registered in the specific order designated by the curriculum. (e.g., Fundamentals of Nursing Science I must be completed prior to enrolling in Fundamentals of Nursing Science II.)

7. Courses within the College of Nursing are conducted on a different schedule module than the standard 75-minute sessions typically used at Korea University. Please ensure you verify the actual class times listed in the "Remarks" column before proceeding with course registration.
